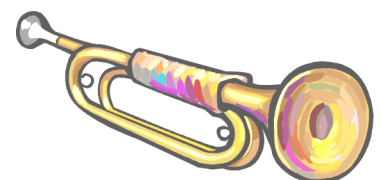

A simple ceremony to remember those who fought for our country. Everyone welcome.

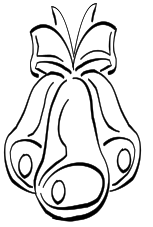
LIBRARY VAN

Our volunteers will be here most Tue afternoons at 2pm in the Activity Room.



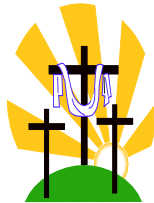
EXERCISES
