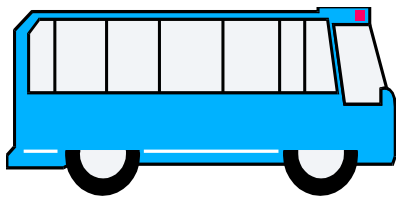
SPECIAL EVENTS THIS MONTH
