## BIRTHDAY PARTY AND HAPPY HOUR

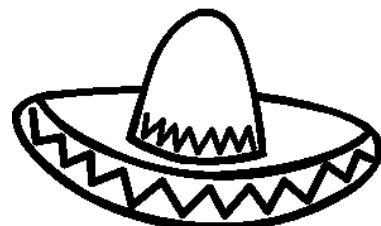
