**Cost:** \$15 (for lunch & transport)

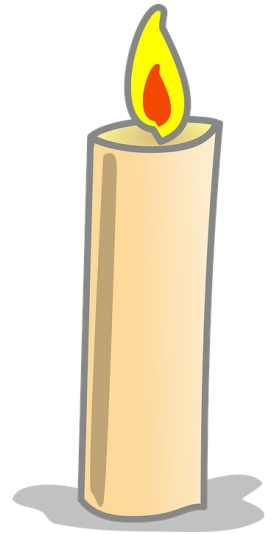


# MEMORIAL SERVICE
