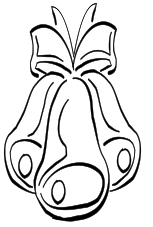
LIBRARY VAN

BBQs in the PARK

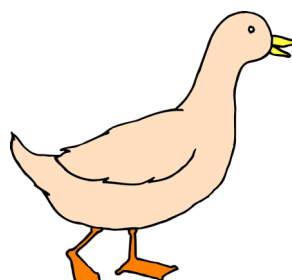
BBQ sausages and rissoles with salad and bread in Lawson Park with the ducks, kids, but hopefully no flies.

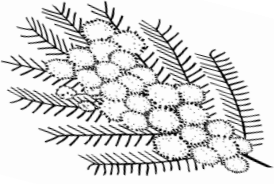
