

By Emily Dickinson


Hope is the thing with feathers That perches in the soul, And sings the tune without the words, And never stops at all,

I've heard it in the chilliest land, And on the strangest sea; Yet, never, in extremity, It asked a crumb of me.

"Hope is the thing with feathers" by Emily Dickinson beautifully personifies hope as a bird that resides in the soul and uplifts the spirit. The poem suggests that hope is a constant companion, singing its tune regardless of the circumstances. It conveys the resilience of hope, even in the face of adversity, and emphasizes that hope requires nothing in return.


